- Ensure that personal protective equipment, such as dust masks, safety glasses, footwear and hardhats, are being used in workplaces according to regulations, and that dangerous materials are correctly labeled and stored.
- Advises and co-operates with area management and field workers in the carrying out of approved safety and environmental programs and alerts management of improvement opportunities
- Attend area safety meetings on a regular basis and provide resource support

- Minimum of 5 years in a HSE Field Advisor role inside the oilfield services is preferred
