

IROC SYSTEMS CORP. ANNOUNCES 2004 FIRST QUARTER RESULTS

Red Deer, AB/ May 11, 2004/ CNW / - Tom Alford, President and CEO of IROC Systems Corp. ("IROC") (TSX Venture: "ISC") announces IROC's financial results for the three months ended March 31, 2004. Revenue for the quarter was \$1,878,480 as compared to \$1,376,617 for the three months ended March 31, 2003. Earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization (EBITDA) increased to \$494,409 in the first quarter of 2004 versus \$152,098 during the first three months of 2003, while the net earnings were \$194,475 for the first quarter of 2004 as compared to net loss of \$5,189 in the corresponding period of 2003.

Mr. Alford commented that, "While IROC continues to operate in an environment supported by strong industry fundamentals, year over year gains in revenue and earnings reflect the success we have had in making the industry more aware of our technology based products and the benefits they provide to our clients. We believe that the industry will sustain activity levels for the remainder of 2004 and beyond, and we are pursuing growth initiatives accordingly."
