

IROC SYSTEMS CORP. ANNOUNCES 2004 THIRD QUARTER RESULTS

Red Deer, AB/ November 29, 2004/ - Tom Alford, President and CEO of IROC Systems Corp. (“IROC”) (TSXV:ISC) announces IROC’s financial results for the nine months ended September 30, 2004. Revenue for the nine months was \$5,818,877 as compared to \$3,557,197 for the nine months ended September 30, 2003. Earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization (EBITDA) was \$761,220 at the end of the nine month period ending September 30, 2004 versus \$260,623 during the first nine months of 2003 while the net loss was \$270,688 for the first nine months of 2004 as compared to the net loss of \$163,391 in the corresponding period of 2003.

Revenue for the three months ending September 30, 2004 increased to \$2,354,920 as compared to \$1,242,892 for the three months ended September 30, 2003. The net loss was \$259,512 for the third quarter of 2004 as compared to the net loss of \$1,374 for the three months ending September 30, 2003.

Mr. Alford commented that, “Industry conditions remain strong with resulting activity levels in Western Canada expected to provide many opportunities for companies like ours to take advantage of to support our desire for growth. We have developed the foundation of our company and now it is up to management to build upon that base.”
