

**IROC SYSTEMS CORP. TO ACQUIRE THE BUSINESS AND  
ASSETS OF KODIAK ENERGY SERVICES LTD.**

Calgary, AB/August 18, 2005/ Tom Alford, President and CEO of IROC Systems Corp. ("IROC" or the "Company") (TSX Venture Exchange: "ISC") announced today that IROC has entered into a letter of intent with Kodiak Energy Services Ltd. ("Kodiak") whereunder IROC will purchase the current assets, certain fixed assets (plus the assumption of certain liabilities related thereto) and the business operations of Kodiak for cash consideration of approximately \$1.8 Million Dollars. Kodiak's operations include lease construction, remediation and waste transportation services. The purchase price is subject to closing adjustments based on current asset values of Kodiak as of the closing date. It is anticipated that the closing of the transaction will be August 31, 2005.

The completion of the transaction is subject to a number of conditions, including, but not limited to the prior receipt of all required regulatory approvals, the support of the receiver and monitor of Kodiak, RSM Richter Inc. and the approval of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta.

IROC Systems Corp. is an Alberta based oilfield services company that has provided equipment and personnel in the area of downwind air quality monitoring and safety services to the energy sector since 1982. Additionally, IROC operates service rigs across Central and Southern Alberta through Eagle Well Services Corp., provides premium communication solutions through Oricomm Inc. and is active in the area of environmental reclamation and remediation through Canstar Environmental Corp., each of which are wholly owned subsidiaries of IROC.
