IROC SYTEMS CORP. ANNOUNCES MANAGEMENT APPOINTMENT

Calgary, AB / April 6, 2006 / Thomas M. Alford, President and CEO of IROC Systems Corp. (“IROC” or the “Company”) (TSX Venture Exchange: “ISC”) announced that IROC has agreed with the shareholders Blowout Control Tools Inc. (“BCTI”) not to proceed with the previously announced proposed purchase by IROC of the all the issued and outstanding shares of BCTI.

Mr. Alford commented that “ while we are disappointed that we will not be proceeding with the acquisition Blowout Control Tools, IROC has reached an agreement with BOP Consulting Systems Inc., one of the principal shareholders of BCTI, for the supply of certain pressure control equipment which will form the basis of IROC’s new oilfield rental division. We expect the build out of our initial rental inventories to be completed through the summer and that the rental division will commence operations sometime during the fourth quarter of 2006.”

The rental division, Aero Rental and Fishing Services, will be headed by Scott Odegard, who assumes the position of General Manager effective immediately. Based in Red Deer, Alberta, IROC will rely on Mr. Odegard's 27 years of experience in the rental business to drive this initiative forward. Mr. Alford commented that “we are very excited that Scott has chosen to join the Company. We believe his experience, knowledge and drive to succeed will be of significant benefit to our Company and our shareholders” Mr Alford further added that “the creation of our rental division is a further example of our stated goal of growing our Company organically while monitoring the market for accretive acquisitions. This platform should accelerate our growth, widen the scope of our product and services, and we believe it will become a significant segment of our Company in the future.”
