

IROC SYSTEMS CORP. COMPLETES A RESTRUCTURING OF SUBDIARIES INTO A CORPORATE PARTNERSHIP

Calgary, AB/February 2, 2006/ IROC Systems Corp. ("IROC" or the "Company") (TSX Venture Exchange: "ISC") announced today that it has completed a restructuring of its subsidiary corporations and business operations into a corporate partnership. The restructuring involved the following steps:

- Eagle Well Servicing Ltd. and Envirocore Ltd. each a wholly owned subsidiary of IROC, amalgamated to form IROC Drilling and Production Services Corp.;
- Oricomm Inc., also a wholly owned subsidiary of IROC, changed its name to IROC Technology Services Corp.; and
- IROC Systems Corp., IROC Drilling and Production Services Corp. and IROC Technology Corp. formed the IROC Energy Services Partnership, a general partnership created under the provisions of the Partnership Act (Alberta).

On a go forward basis the operations of the IROC Group of Companies will be conducted through the IROC Energy Services Partnership.

Tom Alford, the President and Chief Executive Officer commented that "The restructuring of our subsidiaries and the creation of the IROC Energy Services Partnership was undertaken to better align our structure with our intended way of doing business. Also, the Partnership will allow us to simplify and streamline the administration of our operations which were previously carried on within the individual subsidiary corporations."

The restructuring in no way affects the corporate identity, corporate structure, capital structure, share capital or board of directors of IROC Systems Corp.

IROC Systems Corp. is an Alberta based oilfield services company that has provided equipment and personnel in the area of downwind air quality monitoring and safety services to the energy sector since 1982.
