

**IROC SYSTEMS CORP.
ANNOUNCES 2005 AUDITED YEAR END RESULTS**

Calgary, AB / May 1, 2006 / IROC Systems Corp. (“IROC” or the “Company”) (TSX Venture Exchange: “ISC”) announces an update to the financial results provided on April 10, 2006. The Company’s auditor’s have now completed the audit for the year ended December 31, 2005 and as a result of changes to the Company’s stock base compensation expense calculation and the amortization of certain intangibles relating to the Canada Tech Corp. acquisition completed in the fourth quarter of 2005, the previously announced amounts for net earnings and EBITDA have changed to \$2,153,471 and \$7,050,962 respectively. The following is a summary of the final audited financial information (except for the EBITDA calculation) for the year ended December 31, 2005.
