

**IROC SYSTEMS CORP.
ANNOUNCES 2006 FIRST QUARTER RESULTS**

Calgary, AB / May 29, 2006 / IROC Systems Corp. (“IROC” or the “Company”) (TSX Venture Exchange: “ISC”) announces IROC’s financial results for the Company’s first quarter of 2006 being the three months ended March 31, 2006. Revenue for the first quarter was \$19,000,031 as compared to \$5,835,999 for the first quarter of 2005. Earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization (EBITDA) were \$5,123,868 for the first quarter of 2006 as compared to \$1,543,615 for the first quarter of 2005, and net earnings were \$2,048,107 for the first quarter 2006 as compared to \$564,257 for the first quarter of 2005.

Tom Alford, President and CEO of IROC commented that “the Company’s first quarter financial results begin to reflect the growth initiatives the Company implemented during the past few quarters. We are confident that our financial performance will continue to improve during 2006 as more equipment reaches the field pursuant to our ongoing Capital Expenditure Program.”
